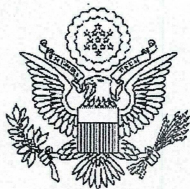

Sponsored by the U.S. Department of State and administered by the Institute of International Education (IIE), FFSP provides scholarships for talented professionals to pursue a master's degree in the United States. Preferred candidates include junior faculty members currently working at higher education institutions in Bangladesh, and junior to mid-level employees at research organizations, think tanks, and NGOs across the public and private sectors. If selected, participants will receive a one-to-two-year grant, beginning in September 2027. Candidates who demonstrate a clear intent to leverage this experience in advancing U.S.-Bangladesh relations are preferred.
